Club Costs

As a club we aim to provide great facilities including ongoing court / club maintenance, new floodlights and new balls on all club evenings but as we are a self-funded club there are some additional costs over and above the membership that we ask for club members to support. These are;

Ball Machine

There is a ball machine available for use for £5. It can be booked on the court booking system. Please remember to fill out the usage log as it helps keep track of maintenance issues, new ball replacement etc. It's self-funding, so please remember to make payments after use. Please note that the balls are designed for machine use and are not to be used for general use. The machine should not be used in wet conditions.

The ball machine can be booked - remember to book a court also.



Guests

Members can bring guests for £5 per visit guest fee.

There is a guest book must which should be filled out **BEFORE** guests play, payment to be made into treasurers' box (envelopes provided) before play commences.

Please note that a guest can only play up to a maximum of 6 times per membership year (April to March).
